SEATTLE BAND MAP: A CARTOGRAPHIC STUDY OF MUSICAL INCEST

The Seattle Band Map is a project that showcases the northwest's vibrant music scene by documenting the thousands of bands who have performed throughout the decades; it also explores how these bands are interconnected through personal relationships and collaborations.

This project aims to diversify the audience for and broaden the understanding of Seattle's music scene, while spotlighting unrepresented artists and musical genres. Seattle has long been known as a hotbed of musical creativity, from the thriving 60s and early 70s Soul and Funk scene, to the 90s grunge movement. Music continues to thrive in Seattle, and we see the Seattle Band Map as an opportunity to keep it in the forefront of people's minds.

Unlike European royalty, this incestual behavior in Seattle rarely leads to bad blood. This zine is an attempt to spread band map fever in Austin, around the country and eventually narrowly getting through customs to Australia. Inside, you will find a band map we drew to show how almost 30 bands from Seattle who are going down to Austin are/were related by shared member. This are by no means all the connections which these bands form (for all connections between over 2000 bands, check out the band map online at seattlebandmap.com and even add your own connections). Also, we are encouraging you to draw out your connections in your own town or own scene. Send it to us! We'd love to display and catalog them.
